

THE PROBLEM

Stolen articles that lack positive identification marks create many police problems. For example:

- ⇒ Property taken into custody by deputies cannot be traced and returned to you. They may be auctioned off, destroyed, or actually returned to the thief upon demand.
- ⇒ The extensive surveillance employed by the deputies over various channels through which stolen property is sold (pawnshops, secondhand stores, etc.) will be neutralized and the thief will be able to profit from his/her crime with virtually no risk of apprehension.
- ⇒ The property cannot be used as evidence against the criminal and he may have to be released without being held accountable for the crime he committed against you and your family.

THE SOLUTION

Use this Valuable Property Record to record your belongings. Also, use an electric marking pencil or engraver to mark your property. Use your Driver's License number, or another number unique to you (Not your Social Security number!) to mark your property in such a way that it is obvious it is yours. Try to mark in an inconspicuous place that the thief will not see to remove.
