



## Carolyn Kingston

**Date of Occurrence: September 2, 1971**

### ABOUT THIS CASE:

Carolyn, age 30, was a clerk at **Natters' Market** at 3065 S. and 700 E. in Salt Lake City, UT on the afternoon of September 2, 1971 when an armed gunman entered the store to commit a robbery. Carolyn had her two small children in the store with her at the time. It's possible she struggled with the suspect.

She and a deliveryman were both shot. The suspect attempted to shoot another deliveryman but the gun did not discharge.

Carolyn died later as a result of her injuries.
