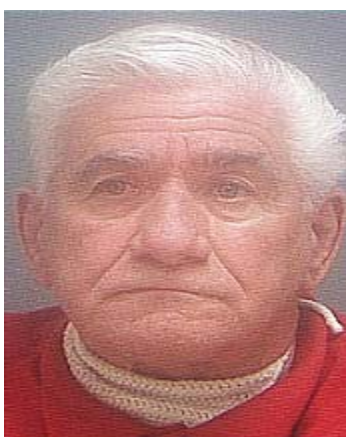

ABOUT THIS CASE:

Gary Feltch, age 49, was shot on June 29, 1990 by Bernard Fred Rigby outside his Holladay home. The shooting resulted from an argument that had taken place earlier at a Salt Lake County tavern over a woman both men were dating. Feltch had been shot once in the neck with a large-caliber weapon. His body was found lying in the doorway of his home by an acquaintance.

In May of 2007 Rigby was charged with first degree murder in the shotgun slaying after new witness information was discovered.

In July of 2009 Rigby entered an Alford plea to the murder, meaning he does not admit to the homicide but recognizes there is sufficient evidence to convince a jury of his guilt.
