ABOUT THIS CASE:

Herbert, age 75, was the founder and president of Tool Design & Manufacturing & Engineering at the time of his death. He was last seen during the day of December 3, 2000 by family members.

Herbert's body was found by a motorist late that evening **near a quarry just off I-80, about 3 miles up Parley's Canyon**. His hands were bound and he had been shot multiple times. It is estimated he was killed between 6:00–8:00pm that evening. His 2000 gold Jeep Cherokee was found two days following the murder in the parking lot of the Little America Hotel located at **500 S. Main Street**.

It is presumed that the vehicle was driven from where Herbert's body was found to the hotel by the suspect(s).
