ABOUT THIS CASE:

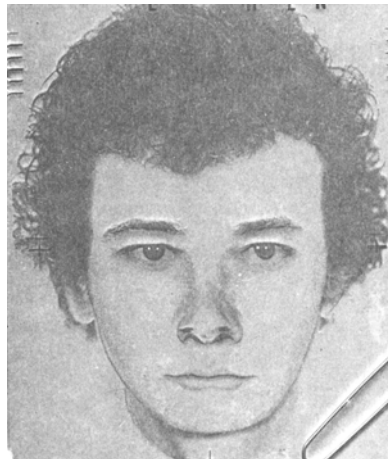
Richard, age 37, and a friend were at the **Oakridge Campground in Big Cottonwood Canyon** on the night of August 21, 1978.

In an unprovoked attack a lone suspect armed with a knife jumped from the nearby bushes and stabbed Richard before fleeing on foot. Richard died as a result of the wounds.

The suspect is described as a young Caucasian or possibly Hispanic male, 18 – 20 years old with a small build; Height: 5'5" – 5'6" Weight: 135 lbs. Hair was described as being dark, short, and very curly.
